Thank you to all who supported our rebuild and Love 21 over the past year! Your generosity and efforts have resulted in Love 21 Foundation being able to significantly improve programmes care for the neurodiverse community in Hong Kong.

I'd also like to thank our Love 21 families for their trust and continued commitment and participation in our ever-growing community. Together we are stronger and I'm so grateful to be on this journey with you.

We just finished another impactful year with loads of progress. During this financial year we increased the number of sports and health classes we offer by 92% to 5400 classes. Our membership also increased by we now support families.



Improving our family support is an area in which we have put a great deal of focus over the past year. We host daily fun health classes for parents only, to give them rest, fun and peer support. We want our Love 21 parents to feel supported and better equipped to handle some of the more difficult challenges they face. Our family support also includes counselling for parents and siblings. Over this past year we supported nearly 50 families with this service.

Our nutrition and dietary programmes are a huge part of our holistic model. The gains and health improvements we have seen through this care have been so inspiring. This past year we have been supporting our members with probiotics to improve their gut health. We have seen such impressive results which were since published in journals and recognised in conferences abroad. We are so excited to give our families this much needed support and will continue strengthening this programme in the coming year.

In this past year we took a large step towards helping more of our members find purpose through employment. We employed and trained nearly 30 of our members and have seen many go on to work in outside companies. Looking forward, employment support will be an area that we will expand as it's so important for us all to have purpose in our lives. Also, amongst our 450 members over 60% are single mother households, which means that extra family income will be another much needed benefit.

Love 21 is on the move! And you may have seen our members at various events and performances around town. As we continuously improve our programme support, we also strive to raise more awareness in this city by providing sharings in corporate workplaces, schools and at external events where our members can showcase their talents and abilities.

Let's all keep doing what we can to ensure that everyone has the best opportunity to reach their potential! We look forward to another exciting year ahead! Thanks again for your support!

### **Renewed Space and Community Resilience**

In the aftermath of the fire that destroyed Love 21 Space, we've received support from many of our corporate and charity partners. In particular, Blue Stone Management reached out and offered to manage the construction project for our new center. Thanks to Blue Stone, as well as other partners such as TCG, S+Techs, CBRE, Slaughter and May, and many more, we were able to locate, refurbish, and open our new center in October 2023.



Our new centre is located in San Po Kong (a few blocks away from our old centre), in a newly refurbished and modern building. We' ve leased two floors in the same building. Our main activity space on the 2/F boasts a high ceiling and open design, and is where most of our sports, dance, and art classes take place. With a large activities room, and dance room, a multipurpose room, and a living area, we expect to be able to increase our class capacity to host more activities for our families.

### A Hub for Healing and Activity

Our space on the 11/F provides a more intimate setting for our one-to-one dietary consultations, as well as our small group training classes to take place. We can also use the 11/F to host smaller training and/or therapeutic sessions for our members.





### **Love 21 New Centre Aims for** 600 Sessions per month by 2024

We expect the new Centre to be fully operational by the start of the next financial year in April 2024, by which time we will be looking to expand our team to fully utilize our space. Our short-term goal for the coming year is to hold at least 600 sessions per month of sports/dance activities, and sessions of one-on-one consultations by the end of the next year.

### EMPOWERING FUTURES LOVE 21'S EMPLOYMENT & DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMS

From June 2022, Love 21 initiated our Employment and Development programme. Through the programme, we provide training and work opportunities for our members. Our members were trained to become Receptionists at our front desk, Assistant Coaches in our sport classes, Activity Assistants in our nutrition programme, and Administrative Assistants to our admin team.




